

A MINI GUIDE TO VOTING IN ILLINOIS

Am I Eligible to Vote?

In IL to be eligible to vote you must...

- Be a United States citizen
- Be a resident of the jurisdiction at least 30 days before the election
- Be 18 by election day
- Register to vote! - check if you are registered at:

How Do I Register to Vote?

Register at: <https://ova.elections.il.gov>

You can register to vote until **Nov 6th!**

- **Online registration** until *Oct 21st*
- **Grace Period registration** at early voting places until *Nov 6th*
- **Election Day registration** at your voting place on *Nov 6th*

Can I Still Vote If I'm An Ex-Convict?

" Individuals incarcerated for a felony conviction are ineligible to vote. Voting rights are automatically restored upon release from prison, and people on parole or probation can vote. **Ex-offenders should re-register to vote.**" - nonprofitvote.org

How Do I Figure Out Who to Vote For?
