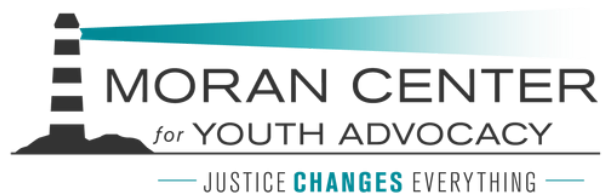

# COMMUNITY IMPACT 2025



From Jan. 1 - Dec. 31, 2025, the Moran Center served more than 1,700 community members with free, holistic integrated legal, social work, and restorative services, advocating in more than 2,100 legal cases.



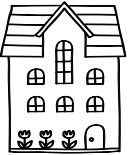
## YOUTH & EMERGING ADULT DEFENSE

We represented **86** young people - **22%** fewer than 2024 - reflecting the continued impact of championed restorative interventions.



## OFFICE RENOVATION

The Moran Center built more private, client-friendly spaces and a community room for Circles, employing justice-involved individuals to help with construction.



## SCHOOL-BASED CIVIL LEGAL CLINIC

We supported **286** families across local school districts in addressing civil legal issues, including evictions, guardianship, and benefit denials.



## EDUCATION ADVOCACY PROGRAM

As school funding cuts strain local schools, **96** students received one-on-one advocacy in special education and discipline cases, leading to improved outcomes.



## INTEGRATED SOCIAL WORK SERVICES

**146** children and teens began healing from trauma, routinizing self care with weekly therapy and other integrated social work services.



## ROGER PASCAL RESTORATIVE JUSTICE INITIATIVE

Our team advised on **28** cases, providing restorative interventions while expanding restorative practices in local schools through student-led circles at Oakton Elementary.



## CRIMINAL RECORD RELIEF PRACTICE

More than **1,276** individuals opened pathways to careers, housing, and education by seeking support to clear their criminal records.



Since welcoming our immigration attorney in fall 2025, the Moran Center has provided more than **195** individuals with Know Your Rights materials and training sessions and had **360** views of our virtual safety planning training.

After ICE's presence near Evanston schools, the Moran Center held healing circles with the students and educators who witnessed violent ICE attacks.

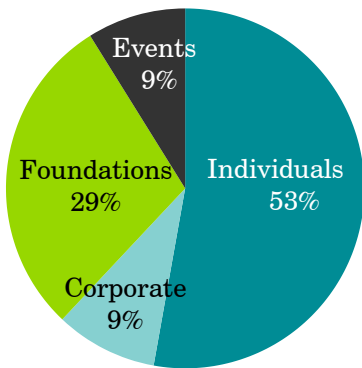

Muhammed walked across the stage as a high school graduate in May 2025.

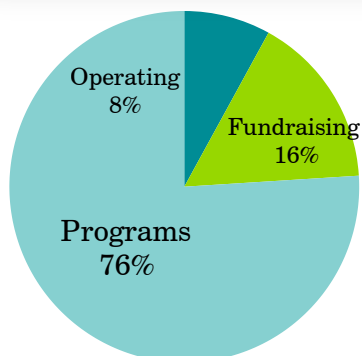
In the years leading up to that moment, he faced school exclusion and involvement in the criminal legal system.
